R&B Superintendent

Supt. Lockman reported that R&B has been dealing with flooded roads, high water and erosion problems. Repairs have been made to Wendover Rd. and Harris Park Rd. and mowing the high grass on the shoulders has begun. Chipsealing will begin August 9th.

County Engineer

County Engineer Kennedy and Supt. Lockman discussed the bridge issue on Happy Hollow Rd. and will consider putting box culverts in place since changing the road is no longer an option. Engineer Kennedy discussed the Industrial Road Project for Cozad Road, C.R. #86. It was decided to not yet approve the Cooperative Agreement between the Wyoming Department of Transportation and the Platte County Commission.

Planning Dept.

Planner Becker presented two zoning certificates for approval.

Gordon Lauts

Landowner Gordon Lauts requested an update on the complaint he filed in 2006 regarding the garbage and junk adjoining his property on Washington Rd. County Attorney Jones will contact the fire marshal to help remedy the situation. Mr. Lauts also requested a 30 mph speed limit sign be placed on Washington Rd between Grange and Ferguson Rds. The Commissioners will contact the R&B Supt. and the Sheriff to see if his request is warranted.

Resolution #2010-09

WHEREAS: the County of Platte has received unanticipated revenue by virtue of the State of Wyoming Department of Health TANF Grant in the amount of \$2,456.00; and

WHEREAS: the County of Platte has received unanticipated revenue by virtue of the State of Wyoming Department of Health MFH Grant in the amount of \$3,594.00; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Wyoming State Statute §16-4-113, the budget of the General fund may be increased by resolution of the governing body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, to amend the County budget to Platte County #100.417.0635 (PH Grants-TANF) in the amount of \$2,456.00 and #100.417.0655 (PH Grants-MFH) in the amount of \$3,594.00 for a total of \$6,050.00.
