Ag Extension Educator Dallas Mount

Extension Educator Dallas Mount introduced Julie M. Daniels, UW Extension Educator, who gave the Board an overview of her services as a Community Development Coordinator.

Hospital Project Manager

Tim O’Konski gave a progress report on the hospital project. A motion was made by Commissioner Kirkbride and seconded by Commissioner Millikin to approve Linx Change Order #2 for added Pharmacy Data Lines and one Nurse Call line. The motion passed. Commissioner Millikin moved and Commissioner Kirkbride seconded to approve Hill-Rom Proposal #179151 for added Code Blue audio station and certification in ER as required by WDOH. The motion passed. Commissioner Millikin moved and Commissioner Kirkbride seconded to accept the bid of \$7,501 for the old hospital generator. The motion passed.

County Sheriff

Sheriff Keigley updated the Board on inmate population and other issues related to the Detention and Sheriff’s office.
