



## Concealed Firearm Permit Requirements & Information

1. You must fill out the Concealed Firearm Permit (CFP) Application, found on the <http://wyomingdci.wyo.gov/dci-criminal-justice-information-systems-section/concealed-firearms-permits> web site, and print off four copies to take to the Sheriff's Office.
2. You must provide a firearm proficiency certificate to the Sheriff's Office. Examples are a military DD214, a hunter safety card, or certification provided by an instructor certified by the National Rifle Association or the Wyoming Law Enforcement Academy.
3. You must be fingerprinted at the Sheriff's Office and a background check is performed on you at the state level before you receive your permit. If for some reason you do not pass, a letter from DCI will be sent to you with the reason why. Be forewarned that if the Sheriff's Office has no one to do prints when you arrive, you may be asked to return another time. We do the prints in our booking room.
4. There is a \$79 fee for new applications and a \$50 fee for a renewal. The \$64 fee will be paid to DCI with a **money order or cashier's check only**. That amount should be brought to the Sheriff's Office when turning in your application. You will also pay \$15 to the Sheriff's Office by cash, money order, cashier's check or personal check. **Expired** renewals up to 6 months are an additional \$10 fee to DCI. Permits expired over 6 months are deemed void. Do not come to the Sheriff's Office to renew more than six months before your permit expires.
5. One copy of the application must be notarized (the Sheriff's Office can do this) and taken to the Driver's Licensing Office where they will take your photo and forward it to DCI.
6. States that recognize Wyoming CFP's include:

**Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New Mexico, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia and West Virginia, Wisconsin**

Be sure to check with each state you will travel to for any special provisions to the reciprocity agreement. Information often can be found on their websites.

If your application is approved, your permit will come to the Sheriff's Office and we will call you for you to pick it up in person. If it is not approved The DCI will send you a letter. The money paid when applying will not be returned.
