
Dear Platte County School District #1,

After reviewing your entity's plan for graduation, you have been approved for an exception to the *State of Wyoming COVID-19 Public Health Order #2: Forbidding Gatherings of 10 people or more*. The approval is contingent upon your entity continuing to meet all targets as detailed in your plan and your understanding of the following:

1. The protection of the health of our community is our #1 concern and priority. As of the week of April 27th, we have seen an increase of positive COVID-19 cases in Wyoming.
2. It is essential you are following the guidance given from the Department of Education. We do not take responsibility for anything in the plans that are outside of the Department of Education recommendations.
3. Please communicate with parents and students that a new outbreak locally may force us to cancel the graduation ceremony. All students need to be prepared for this.
4. This approval only applies to entities in Platte County and does not apply statewide.

As the pandemic is a fluid situation, unforeseen circumstances either locally, statewide or nationally may require a withdrawal of this exemption at any time and without notice.
