## SYMPTOMS\* OF CORONAVIRUS DISEASE

**Patients with COVID-19 have reportedly had mild to severe respiratory illness. Symptoms can include**

- Fever
- Cough
- Shortness of breath

**\* Symptoms may appear 2–14 days after exposure. If you have been in China within the past 2 weeks and develop symptoms, call your doctor.**

# NON PHARMACEUTICAL INTERVENTION

## Individual Measures – ‘Hygienic’

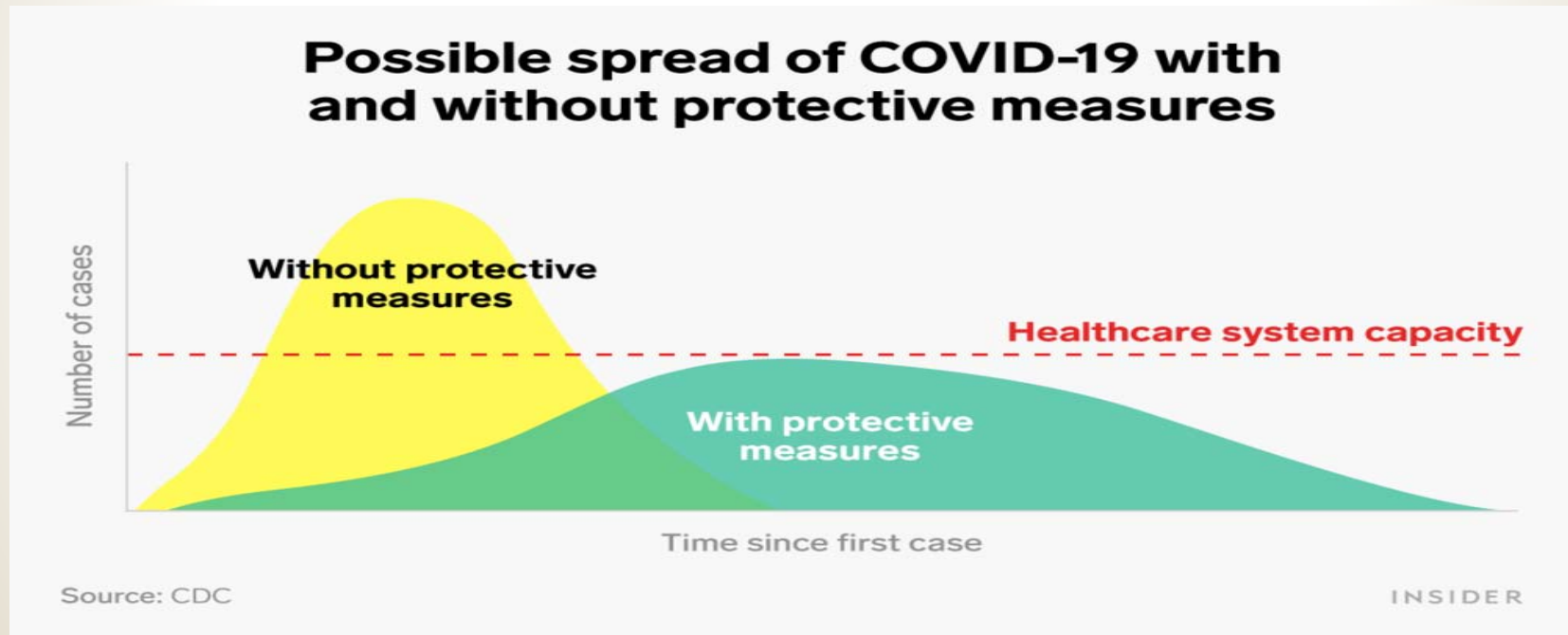
- **Hand washing**
  - Wash for 20 seconds with soap and water.
  - If you cannot wash your hands use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol
- **Cough etiquette**
  - Cough in elbow or turn away
- **Washing inanimate surfaces**
- **Masks & respirators**
  - Making your own Mask does not show to be effective per CDC.

## Community-based Measures

- **Self-isolation (proven sick/testing for COVID-19 pending)**
- **Self-quarantine (have been around or traveled to a high risk area)**
- **Social Distancing Measures**
  - Work Place Policies
  - Gatherings restrictions
  - Travel restrictions

# SOCIAL DISTANCING



## AVOID

- Group gatherings
- Sleep overs or playdates
- Concerts, theaters, or eating in restaurants
- Athletic events or gyms
- Malls or retail stores



## USE CAUTION

- Grocery shopping
- Getting take out
- Picking up medications
- Checking on friends or elderly neighbors



## SAFE TO DO

- Taking a walk or going for a hike
- Cleaning
- Attending an online church service
- Read or listen to music
- Family game night

## How?



**Wet** your hands with clean, running water (warm or cold), turn off the tap, and apply soap.



**Lather** your hands by rubbing them together with the soap. Be sure to lather the backs of your hands, between your fingers, and under your nails.



**Scrub** your hands for at least 20 seconds. Need a timer? Hum the “Happy Birthday” song from beginning to end twice.



**Rinse** hands well under clean, running water.



**Dry** hands using a clean towel or air dry them.
