

RESOLUTION #2013-05

REGARDING SPEED LIMIT ON
COUNTY ROAD # 86 COZAD ROAD

WHEREAS: the Platte County Board of Commissioners have the supervision, management and control of County roads pursuant to State Law, W.S. §24-1-04 (Lexis 2012) as amended; and

WHEREAS: the Platte County Commissioners are authorized pursuant to W.S. §31-5-303(Lexis 2012) as amended, to establish maximum speed limits on County roads; and

WHEREAS: the length of County Road #86, Cozad Road, is approximately 5,300 feet, the railroad crossing and the proximity to residences provides evidence a lower speed limit is reasonable and necessary for the safety of all citizens.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners in and for Platte County do hereby set the maximum speed limit for County Road #86, Cozad Road, at 30 miles per hour effective when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected upon said County road.


