RESOLUTION TO RESCIND FIRE BAN IN PLATTE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Platte County Fire Warden has recommended on this day to rescind the partial closure of all of Platte County, Wyoming, to use open fires and the use of incendiary devices; and

WHEREAS, the fire danger in Platte County has improved due to lower temperatures and recorded precipitation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Platte County, Wyoming, that effective November 18, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. Platte County Resolution #2016-09 is rescinded in its entirety.


