

RESOLUTION #2017-15
SPEED LIMIT FOR PALMER CANYON ROAD

WHEREAS, the Platte County Board of Commissioners have the supervision, management and control of County roads pursuant to State Law, §24-1-104 W.S. 1977 as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Platte County Commissioners are authorized pursuant to W.S. §31-5-303 to establish speed limits on County roads; and

WHEREAS, the Platte County Commissioners have received a recommendation from the County Sheriff and the Road & Bridge Supervisor in regard to Palmer Canyon Road; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned Platte County Commissioners have determined that the maximum speed permitted or established under Wyoming law is greater than is reasonably safe under the conditions found to exist upon the County road and portions thereof listed below and that those speed limits should be decreased to the levels set forth below;

WHEREAS, the maximum speed limit for Palmer Canyon Road should be 10 mph from the bottom of the hill on the east side of the Laramie River to the cattle guard on the west side.

NOW THEREFORE be it hereby resolved that the maximum speed limit for Palmer Canyon Road from the bottom of the hill on the east side of the Laramie River to the cattle guard on the west side be 10 mph and is posted accordingly.
