

# PLATTE COUNTY RESOLUTION #2019-11

## A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE OFFICIAL HOLIDAYS FOR COUNTY EMPLOYEES FOR THE YEAR 2020

**WHEREAS**, per Wyoming Statute §18-3-103 as amended, county officers shall keep their offices open during the usual business hours of each day excluding Saturdays, Sunday, legal holidays and other days as established by the County Commissioners through resolution, and;

**WHEREAS**, it is understood that this resolution shall not apply to all county departments as some are required to be in operation continuously. All law enforcement personnel will be compensated with pay at time and a half for those hours worked on the actual holiday.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Platte County Board of Commissioners of Platte County Wyoming that the list of holidays and other days as set forth below shall be observed during calendar year 2020 for Platte County employees:


