A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A FEDERAL MINERAL ROYALTY CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION ACCOUNT GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE LOAN & INVESTMENT BOARD ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF PLATTE COUNTY, WYOMING FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING TWO FIRE COMMAND UNITS

WHEREAS, the Governing Body for the County of Platte desires to participate in the Federal Mineral Royalty Capital Construction Account Grant program to assist in financing this project, and;

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the County of Platte recognizes the need for the project, and;

WHEREAS, the Federal Mineral Royalty Capital Construction Account Grant program requires that certain criteria be met, as described in the State Loan & Investment Board's Rules and Regulations governing the program, and to the best of our knowledge this application meets those criteria, and;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF PLATTE COUNTY, WYOMING, that the grant application in the amount of \$68,294.00 be submitted to the State Loan & Investment Board for consideration at their June 16, 2020 State Loan & Investment Board meeting to assist in funding the purchase of two fire command units.


