**A RESOLUTION CLOSING THE COUNTY COURTHOUSE FOR THE 2020 PRIMARY
AND GENERAL ELECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Platte County Commissioners believe in the importance that each qualified elector of the County expresses their right to vote, and;

WHEREAS, recent directives from the Wyoming Secretary of State have required the hiring of additional election judges, and;


WHEREAS, the Platte County Clerk, Malcolm Ervin, has requested that the Treasurer, District Court and Assessor Offices serve in the coming elections to ensure there are sufficient election judges to conduct the 2020 Primary and General Elections, and;

WHEREAS, the County Clerk's Office must remain open to receive absentee ballots and for public observation of the absentee counting and reception boards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF PLATTE COUNTY, WYOMING, that on Tuesday, August 18, 2020 and Tuesday, November 3, 2020 the County Courthouse, located at 800 9th Street, Wheatland, will be closed to the public, with the exception election-related business, and all other county offices shall continue their normal business.
