

**PLATTE COUNTY RESOLUTION #2020-28**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A CORONAVIRUS RELIEF GRANT APPLICATION TO THE STATE LOAN & INVESTMENT BOARD ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNING BODY FOR THE COUNTY OF PLATTE FOR THE PURPOSE OF SEEKING GRANT FUNDS FOR NECESSARY EXPENDITURES INCURRED DUE TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY WITH RESPECT TO COVID-19.**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of Platte County desires participate in the Coronavirus Relief Grant program to assist in financing this request; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of Platte County recognizes the need for the request; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Coronavirus Relief Grant program requires that certain criteria be met, as described in the State Loan and Investment Board's Rules and Regulations governing the program, and to the best of our knowledge this application meets those criteria; and,

**WHEREAS**, if any of the disbursed grant funds are later deemed to not comply with the SLIB criteria or the criteria of the CARES Act, the grant applicant agrees to repay the ineligible grant funds within fifteen days of such finding to the Office of State Lands and Investments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF PLATTE COUNTY, WYOMING**, that a grant application in the amount of \$9,240.00 be submitted to the State Loan and Investment Board for consideration at the next Board meeting after application process to assist in funding the Platte County I.T. Response to COVID-19 Related Cyber Threats.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Malcolm Ervin, Platte County Clerk, is hereby designated as the authorized representative of Platte County to act on behalf of the Governing Body on all matters relating to this grant application.
