

**PLATTE COUNTY RESOLUTION #2020-35**

**A RESOLUTION CONCERNING PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)  
IN COUNTY FACILITIES**

**WHEREAS**, Platte County as an entity is liable for the health and safety of its employees and the public upon entering a County-owned facility or on a County job-site; and,

**WHEREAS**, requiring the proper use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is considered by this governing body to be a proactive step towards reducing the potential risk of diminished health and safety of County employees and the public in County facilities and while performing County work; and,

**WHEREAS**, Platte County's worker's compensation and liability insurance rates can fluctuate depending on certain proactive policies or trainings to reduce potential risks for injury.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of Platte County, Wyoming, that each department head and elected official shall be permitted to require certain PPE for their offices and job-sites as they see prudent to ensure the health and safety of the County's citizens and its employees.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that PPE shall include, but not be limited to: bullet proof vests, eye protection, face coverings, gloves, hard hats, hearing protection, reflective outerwear and steel-toed boots.
