

PLATTE COUNTY RESOLUTION #2021-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) APPLICATION TO THE WYOMING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (WCDA) FOR THE PLATTE COUNTY 16TH STREET DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PROJECT: Necessary safety improvements, flood control and economic development of 16th; the primary business corridor for Wheatland and Platte County.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the **County of Platte** desires to participate in the Community Development Block Grant Program to assist in financing of this project; and

WHEREAS, the public benefit(s) of this project are to **provide a safe, accessible and attractive street for businesses, residents and travelers, to create a business-friendly atmosphere for the entire community and to encourage business expansion and new development along 16th Street therefore creating additional jobs within our community**; and

WHEREAS, this project will meet the Wyoming CDBG State-level Objective of Engaging in the development and expansion of public services, with an emphasis upon rural and under-served areas; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the **County of Platte** plans to provide the cash match to this Community Development Block Grant project.

WHEREAS, In the event of any project cost overruns, the **County of Platte** will provide funding in the amount necessary to complete the project from its **General Fund**; and

WHEREAS, the **County of Platte** held a public hearing on **September 21, 2021** to solicit testimony from citizens and gave full consideration to all comments received; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF PLATTE COUNTY, WYOMING, that a grant application in the amount of **\$750,000.00** be submitted to the Wyoming Community Development Authority for consideration of assistance in funding the **16th Street Development Project**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that **Malcolm Ervin, Platte County Clerk** is hereby designated as the authorized representatives of the **County of Platte** to act on behalf of the Governing Body on matters relating to this grant application.
