AMENDMENT TO THE 2020 – 2021 BUDGET

WHEREAS, Platte County has received unanticipated revenue, in the sum of \$1,175,608.49, by virtue of being awarded the following grants:

CRF-260, Sheriff's Office Mobile Reporting - \$80,733.00 (Revenue Acct. 534)

CFDA 93.323, COVID-19 Surveillance & Testing - \$104,076.00 (Revenue Acct. 536)

WHEREAS, Platte County also received unanticipated revenue from additional federal inmates housed at the Platte County Detention Center in the sum of \$215,000 (Revenue Acct. 530); and,


WHEREAS, the budget of the general fund may be increased by resolution pursuant to Wyoming State Statute §16-4-113; and,


