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## **Qualifications for Holding Office**

Pursuant to W.S. 6-10-106, a person convicted of a felony is incompetent to hold any office of honor, unless he has had a complete and full restoration of rights, not just voting rights. If you have any questions regarding your ability to hold office, please ask the County Clerk for clarification.

### **ALL COUNTY OFFICES, INCLUDING DISTRICT ATTORNEY**

No person except a qualified elector shall be elected or appointed to any civil or military office in the state. (Wyo. Constitution, Art. 6, Sec. 15)

#### **COUNTY ASSESSOR**

In addition to being a qualified elector, the county assessor shall own real property in the county in which he is elected. (W.S. 18-3-201)

#### **COUNTY ATTORNEY**

In addition to being a qualified elector, the county attorney shall be a member of the bar of Wyoming. (W.S. 18-3-301)

#### **DISTRICT ATTORNEY**

In addition to being a qualified elector, the district attorney shall be a licensed attorney for at least four (4) years and a member in good standing of the Wyoming state bar immediately prior to his election. (W.S. 9-1-802)
